COVENANT GENESIS 128B

PROMISE GENESIS 112,4

AND YAHWEH ELOHIM SAID TO THE SNAKE,

I WILL SET HOSTILITY BETWEEN YOU AND THE WOMAN, AND BETWEEN YOUR SEED AND HER SEED; HE WILL STRIKE YOUR HEAD AND YOU WILL STRIKE HIS HEEL.

OUT OF THE GARDEN GENESIS 323-24

...AND YAHWEH ELOHIM SENT HIM OUT FROM THE GARDEN TO WORK THE GROUND FROM WHICH HE WAS TAKEN, AND HE BANISHED THE HUMAN.
