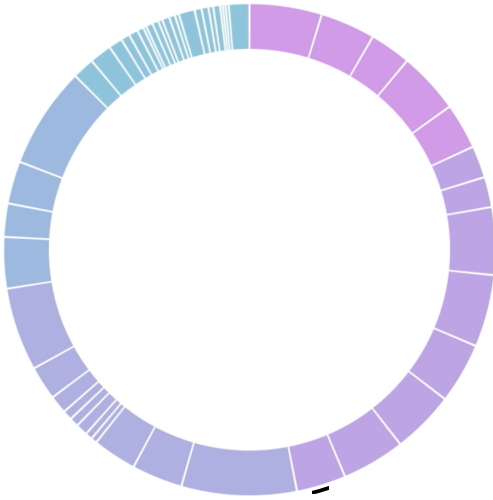
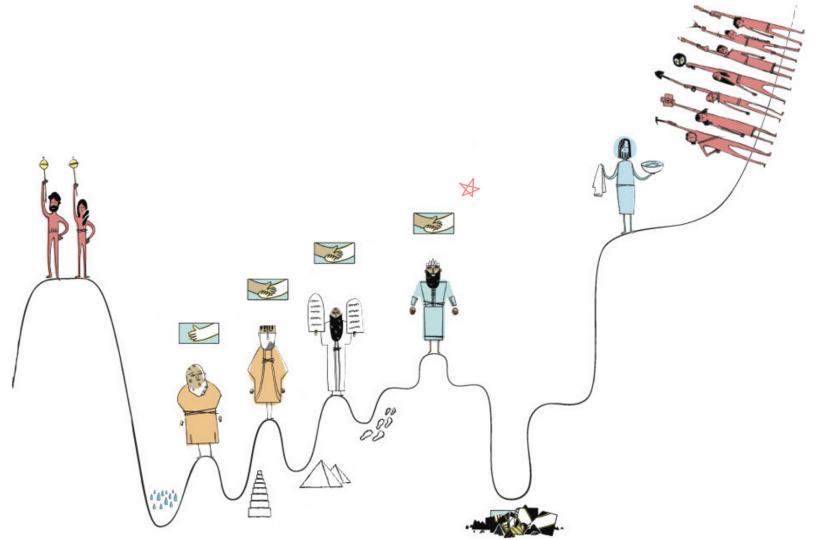

And Yonah arose to flee to Tarshish from before the face of Yahweh and he went down to Joppa and he found a ship which was going to Tarshish and he paid the fare and he went down into it to go with them to Tarshish from before the face of Yahweh. (1:3)

And Yahweh hurled a great wind to the sea and there was a great storm on the sea, and the ship considered breaking apart. And the sailors feared and each cried to his elohim, and they hurled the cargo which was in the ship to the sea to make it lighter from upon them. And Yonah went down into the far reaches of the ship, and he laid down and fell asleep. (1:4-5)

And the word of Yahweh was to Yonah a second time, saying: "Arise, go to Nineveh the great city, and call out to it the calling-out which I am speaking to you. (3:1)

And it was evil to Yonah, a great evil, and there was heat-anger to him. And he prayed to Yahweh and he said, "Please, Yahweh! Was not this my word while I was upon my land? Therefore I acted before to flee to Tarshish, because I knew that you are a Elohim, gracious and compassionate, slow-to-anger, and great of covenant love, and who repents concerning evil. (4:1-2)
